



Vendor FAQ's

Q: How do you select vendors for your events?

A: We choose our vendors based off many criteria.

- What does their social media presence look like? Their Marketing?
- Product presentation and quality? Is it locally produced and locally made?
- Are they professional communicators and foster good business values?
- Are they supportive of other small businesses, even if they are in the same product category?
- Do they bring positive energy and engage with patrons at the markets?

Q: What is your refund policy?

A: All vendor fee sales are final. If a vendor cannot make it to a market/event, fees collected will transfer towards a future market/events.

If a vendor is a no show without notification (except in the rare case of emergencies), the table vending fee is forfeited.

Q: Can I request a space that I want to vend?

A: Yes. You can request a space by paying in advance for the space requested. The minimum time for a space request is four weeks.

Q: How often do you host Table Vending events?

A: Table vending normally runs Tuesday through Saturday! We are expecting to grow and build the small business community.

Q: Do you require permits or business licenses to participate in events?

A: No. However, we do require vendors to have ServSafe and Cottage License or ServSafe and Fulton County License for food handler and liability insurance for some products.



Q: Do you require vendors to participate in a minimum # of events

A: No. Once approved a vendors can provide the days they want to table vend for approval.

Q: Will you have multiple vendors at your Market with the same products?

A: While we do not guarantee category exclusivity, we try to have a nice variety of vendors, without taking away business from one vendor or another. There can be more than one vendor with the same items, but we try to separate them.

Q: What type of businesses are typically accepted at the markets?

A: We love to support local artisans, handmade crafters, and small businesses. We accept locally produced pre-packaged foods (jams, jellies, honey, popcorn, snacks, candy, tea), desserts, macramé, jewelry, fashion, accessories, candles, perfumes, pet supplies, and the list goes on.

Q: What type of businesses do you NOT accept at the markets?

A: Currently, we do not accept THC-based cannabis products, resellers of products. We also do not accept smoke shops, wholesalers, weapons dealers, chain restaurants, and Political or Religious Propaganda.

Q: In what instance will an event be cancelled/rescheduled?

A: Inclement weather that poses safety concerns that would cause us to close the market. Thank you for understanding.

Q: What happens if I opt-in for discount parking and forget to get my parking validated and stamped?

A. The gate attendance will charge you the full price for parking in the lot. Getting you parking ticket validated is your responsibility before you set-up.
